Focusing on recognizing and evaluating a hazardous materials incident, organizing the response team, identifying and using response resources, decision-making, and protecting the public and environment, the curriculum contains approximately 24 hours of classroom presentation and 16 hours of hands-on exercises and equipment use. This enables the practical application of all lecture and hands-on information the students have received.

The Hazmat course also meets NIMS requirements for hazardous materials response teams and addresses the competencies of 29 CFR 1910.120, Michigan's CIS/OHS-HAZWOPER Part 432, NFPA 472, and HMEP Guidelines.
